Playing Format

- Format: 7 v 7 with squads up to 11 players
- Game Length: 2 x 18-minute halves, 2-minute halftime
- Start/Finish: All games controlled by an air horn
- Field Size: 60m x 40m with 8m x 12m penalty area (roughly)
- Ball: Size 4 (all teams must supply their own ball)
- Refereeing: Each team referees one half
- Retreating Line: In play (also acts as the offside line)
- Goalkeeper Rules: No kicks from hand directly from hands (infringement = indirect free kick).
- Rules: NRF 7v7 Junior Football rules apply. Click [here](#) for a for NRF junior handbook

- Goals: Each team is responsible for setting up and packing down. Please allow 15 mins before kick-off.
- Uniforms: Each team will be assigned a colour to prevent any colour clash.

- 9th/10th Grade (combined): Born 2015/16
- 11th/12th Grade (combined): Born 2013/14
- **No over/under age players permitted. Playing ineligible players will result in a 3-0 win for opposition and 2 point deduction.**
- Female players may play one age grade down (per NZ Football & NRF regulations).
- Any special dispensation requests must go through the Director of Football.
